**MBS CRITERIA FOR STRESS ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY (FROM 1 AUG 2020)**

Please tick ONE or more of the appropriate boxes below

- Typical or Atypical angina (must meet one of either):
  - Discomfort in chest, neck, jaw or upper limbs
  - Symptoms with physical exertion
  - Symptoms that are relieved by rest or within 5 mins of GTN
- Abnormal ECG suggestive of ischaemia without known CAD
- Exertional dyspnoea of uncertain cause
- Where silent ischaemia is suspected OR Accurate assessment of symptoms on clinical history is not possible
- Known CAD with possible recurrence in angina
- Possible functionally significant CAD on CT coronary angiography
- Valvular heart disease (assessment of significant AS or MR)

**MBS CRITERIA FOR ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY (FROM 1 AUG 2020)**

Please tick ONE or more of the appropriate boxes below

- If your patient has had an echocardiogram within the last 24 months from 1st August 2020 please tick the relevant indication to ensure eligibility for a medicare rebate
- Heart Failure or structural heart disease (not valvular dysfunction)
  - The patient is commenced on a medication for non-cardiac purposes that have cardiotoxic side effects and the patient has a normal baseline study which requires echocardiograms to comply with the prescribing requirements of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme.
  - Pericardial effusion/pericarditis
  - If the referring GP works in a modified Monash model area 3-7 then referral for assessment of valvular dysfunction is valid more often than every 2 years.
- For the majority of other resting echocardiography requests where the patient has had a study in the preceding 24 months a specialist consultation will be required in order to access a medicare rebate.
